

IADE TOXINS 2026
Congress Regulations

I. General Provisions

1. The terms used in these Regulations refer to the definitions specified in the General Regulations of the events organized by IADE Sp. z o. o. and also to the following definitions:
 - a) **Regulations** – these Congress Regulations which also govern the provision of electronic services;
 - b) **General Regulations** – the regulations and also the regulations for the provision of electronic services, applicable to all the Events organized by the Organizer, regardless of their type, venue, dates and form (onsite, online or hybrid), provided that the Regulations of these specific Events do not specify otherwise;
 - c) **Congress** – a training and scientific event, named IADE TOXINS 2026 organized by the Organizer;
 - d) **Organizer** - IADE Sp. z o.o. with the registered office in Warsaw, address: Kosiarzy str. No.: 9A, 02-953 Warszawa, incorporated in the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw, Department No.: 14 for Commercial Affairs of the National Court Register with the KRS number: 0001186906, NIP [tax identification number]: 1133175963; REGON [business classification number]: 54243599400000; email: kontakt@iade.pl; phone: +48 608 816 900;
 - e) **Website** – portal operated and administered by the Organizer at www.iade.pl devoted to IADE TOXINS, and used, among other things, to register passive participants and to perform other activities related to the execution of the Contract.
2. The Regulations stipulate the rights and obligations of the Contracting Parties, Participants and Congress Organizer.
3. These Regulations will be available on the Congress website and at the Congress registration desk.
4. The Contracting Parties and the Participants are obliged to read the Regulations and the General Regulations before the execution of the Contract and participation in the Congress.
5. These Regulations and the General Regulations are binding on all Contracting Parties and Congress Participants who are obliged to observe all the provisions thereof.
6. The Congress is intended for medical doctors. The event may include content or advertisements related to medical products intended for use by experts (i.e. professionals qualified in an appropriate field of healthcare or medicine).
7. The Congress will be held onsite and online. Online participation in the Congress is available for purchase only to passive participants.
8. The Congress will be conducted in English. The organizer will provide simultaneous interpretation of lectures and workshops into Polish.
9. The Congress IADE TOXINS is scheduled to take place on April 17th-18th 2026 at the InterContinental Hotel, at the following address: Emilii Plater 49, 00-125 Warsaw and will be streamed online via the website www.iade.pl at the following times:

10. The detailed program of the Congress is available at www.iade.pl.
11. Each passive Participant, taking part in the Congress will receive the certificate of participation in the Congress in accordance with the terms as outlined in the General Regulations.

II. Participation, Participant Registration and Resignation

1. The Contracting Party has the right to withdraw from participation in the Congress by March 10th, 2026, without incurring any financial consequences.
2. In the event of withdrawal by the Contracting Party after March 10th, 2026, the Contracting Party shall be obliged to pay the full Participation Fee, in accordance with the Contract executed between the Parties and the provisions of the General Regulations.
3. The withdrawal must be expressed in writing and sent to the Organizer's registered office, under pain of invalidity. The date of receipt of the letter at the Organizer's registered office will determine on the acceptance of the withdrawal.
4. The rules for registration and participation of Exhibitors are specified in the Terms and Conditions of participation.
5. The Organizer does not provide an Account for the Participants.

III. Payments

1. The participation in the Congress is subject to payment.
2. The Commissioning Party is obliged to pay the Participation Fee in accordance with the price list included in the Regulations and on the Congress website.
3. The fee for passive participation in the Congress shall be made by bank transfer to the account provided by the Organizer, within 7 days of serving the Commissioning party with the proforma invoice or through the service of an external provider of electronic payment services (Płatności24).

IV. Participation fees

1. The fee for passive stationary participation in the Congress is:

2. The fee for passive online participation in the Congress, available solely for the passive participants is:

5. The fee for passive stationary participation includes admission to all lectures and workshops throughout the Congress, all-day coffee breaks, lunch, and the certificate of participation issued in electronic form.

6. The fee for passive online participation in the Congress includes the access to real-time broadcasts of lectures from one conference room, and the certificate of participation issued in electronic form.
7. The participation fee does not include post-conference proceedings which are not covered by the conference package. The Organizer reserves the right to send the post-conference proceedings to the participant, via time-limited electronic access (link, which expires after a specified time period, and the Participants will not be able to claim the access the materials.
8. The Participants may purchase a 30-day access to the recorded lectures in one of the Congress rooms for 1,000.00 PLN (VAT inclusive).

V. Terms of providing electronic services to passive participants

1. The online participation in the Congress consists in obtaining access to the digital contents via live broadcast of the Congress on the day of the event provided on the Website.

VI. The terms for participation in the Congress and the terms of liability

1. At the end of the Congress, the Participants verified in accordance with the General Regulations will receive an electronic certificate confirming their participation in the Congress. The certificate will be sent by email to the email address provided at registration.

VII. Image and recording

1. During the event, the Congress area (exhibition and lecture space) will be covered by video surveillance which does not cover sanitary facilities. The detailed information is provided in point XI of the General Regulations.

IX. Withdrawal from the Contract

1. The details concerning the right to withdraw from the contract can be found in the General Regulations.
2. A Participant wishing to exercise their right to withdraw from the Contract, must submit a clear statement to the Organizer's registered office or by email to: kontakt@iadea.pl.

X. Complaints

1. General Regulations contain a section concerning the procedures regarding complaints.
2. All the complaints should be submitted in registered letters with a receipt confirmations to the Organizer's registered office or via email to: kontakt@iade.pl.

XI. Personal data protection

1. General Regulations and Privacy policy contain information on personal data protection.

2. The Organizer wishes to inform that during the event, the Congress area (exhibition and lecture space) will be covered by video surveillance which does not cover sanitary facilities. The monitoring is carried out to ensure the safety of persons and property, for possible findings, investigations, or defence against claims (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR). Only images (without sound) are recorded and stored on a digital medium. Camera recordings are stored for up to 7 days from the end of the Congress or until the end of the proceedings in which the recording may serve as evidence, and then will be deleted. Recordings may only be made available to institutions authorized to access personal data pursuant to applicable law.

XII Final provisions

1. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Regulations, for reasonable causes and to the extent that is necessary. The contracts concluded before the amendment of the Regulations will be governed by the version of these Regulation in effect on the date of concluding the Contact. The amendment of the Regulations will be effective within not less than 14 days of the publication of the amended version of the Regulations on the Website.
2. The Regulations will be effective from January 1st, 2026 onwards.
